OPEN WATER DIVER

The Open Water Diver rating is the entry point to diving most of the world with 4 certification dives.

ADVANCED ADVENTURER

The Advanced Adventurer program is designed to be a sampler of 5 specialty dives to explore specialty opportunities. This does not allow you to earn a specialty rating, but your dives can be counted toward specialties later.

SPECIALTY DIVER

The Specialty Diver rating recognizes divers who complete 2 specialty courses and have logged a minimum of 12 open water dives.

(Not sure what specialties to take? Start with Advanced Adventurer!)

ADVANCED DIVER

The Advanced Diver program teaches new and beneficial skills while rewarding the diver for achieving a higher level of education and experience. Upon completion of the Advanced Diver program, the diver will have earned 4 specialties and logged a minimum of 24 open water dives.

MASTER DIVER

The Master Diver rating is one of SSI's most prestigious diver ratings. When you carry this card, you carry the pride and experience that goes with it. A Master Diver must successfully complete 4 specialties and the Diver Stress Rescue course and have logged 50 or more dives.
